



CAP Beneficiaries Support Services

The Computer/Electronic Accommodations Program (CAP) provides assistive technology to assist family members with disabilities that participate in the Military Treatment Facilities (MTFs), the Exceptional Family Member Program (EFMP), and the DoD Education Activity (DoDEA).

CAP has expert staff to assist in identifying and purchasing appropriate technical enhancements to ensure that DoD programs and facilities are accessible to people with disabilities, as required by Federal laws.

Military Treatment Facilities

- CAP provides the necessary electronic and communication equipment to increase MTF accessibility for people with cognitive, communication, dexterity, hearing and vision disabilities.
- The *Americans with Disabilities Technical Assistance Manual* (located at www.usdoj.gov/crt/ada/adahom1.htm) contains additional information regarding accessibility requirements for public health facilities.

Exceptional Family Member Program

- CAP works with the EFMP coordinator, Family Service Center Personnel and the family to:
 - determine equipment needs
 - identify solutions
 - provide assistive technology when appropriate

DoD Education Activity

- CAP provides appropriate assistive technology for shared locations such as libraries, by working with teachers, special education directors, students, employees and supervisory personnel to identify and provide appropriate solutions.
