ELIGIBILITY

To participate in the WRP, students and recent graduates must:

- Apply through your school's career center or disability services office.
- Be a US Citizen
- Have a Schedule A qualified disability
- Be a current secondary university, undergraduate, graduate/doctoral student or
- Recent graduate from a U.S. accredited college or university.
